As you are aware, the Golf Club has been without a Golf Course Superintendent since the middle of February 2025. A big thank-you to a very capable group of Volunteers who have kept the golf course in top shape since the superintendent left.

The Golf Club started advertising for a replacement in late January 2025 and applications closed on 27th February 2025.

In total we had seven well qualified Golf Course Superintendents ask for details about the position, five Victorian based and two interstate candidates but only five applied for the position.

The Selection Panel comprising of the President Mick Elliot, Vice President John Kerr and Secretary Greg Martin interviewed the five candidates early last week and then conducted two follow-up interviews to make the final decision.

The General Committee is happy to announce that the new Golf Course Superintendent will be Glenn McCormick from Muckleford South (Castlemaine) and he will commence his duties with the Club on Thursday 13th March 2025.
